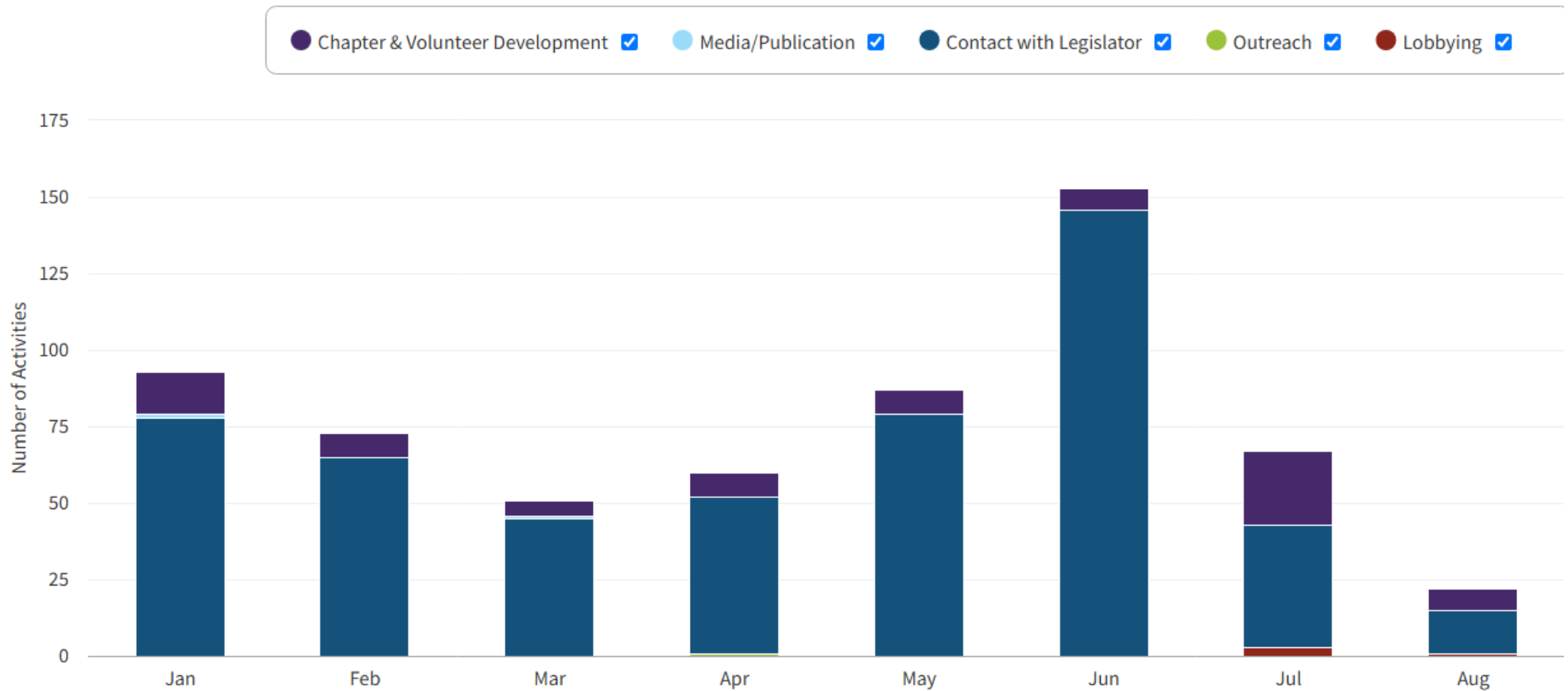

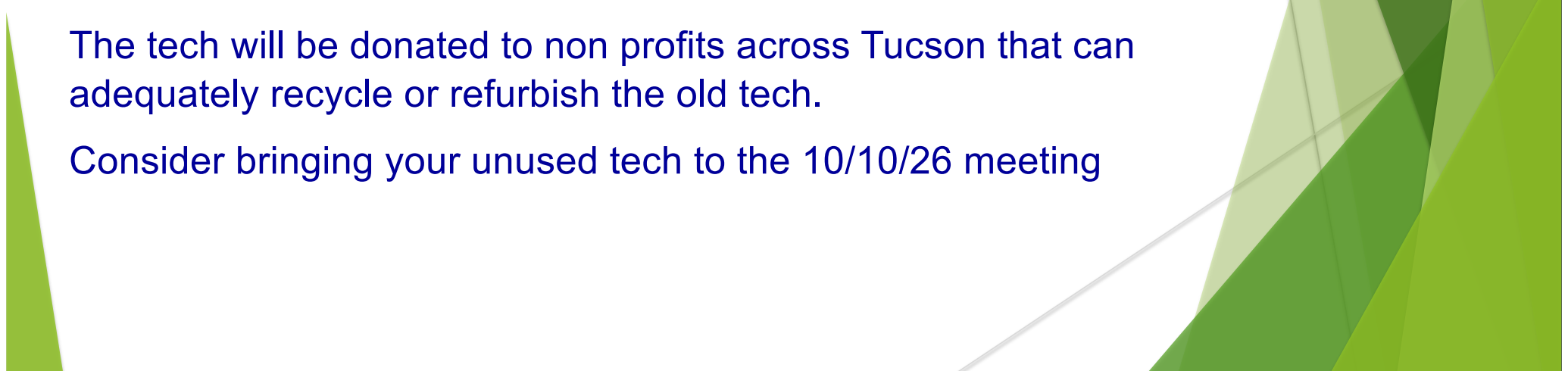
New school year and gearing up

Tech drive with the objective of collecting old and unwanted tech in order to reduce e-waste.

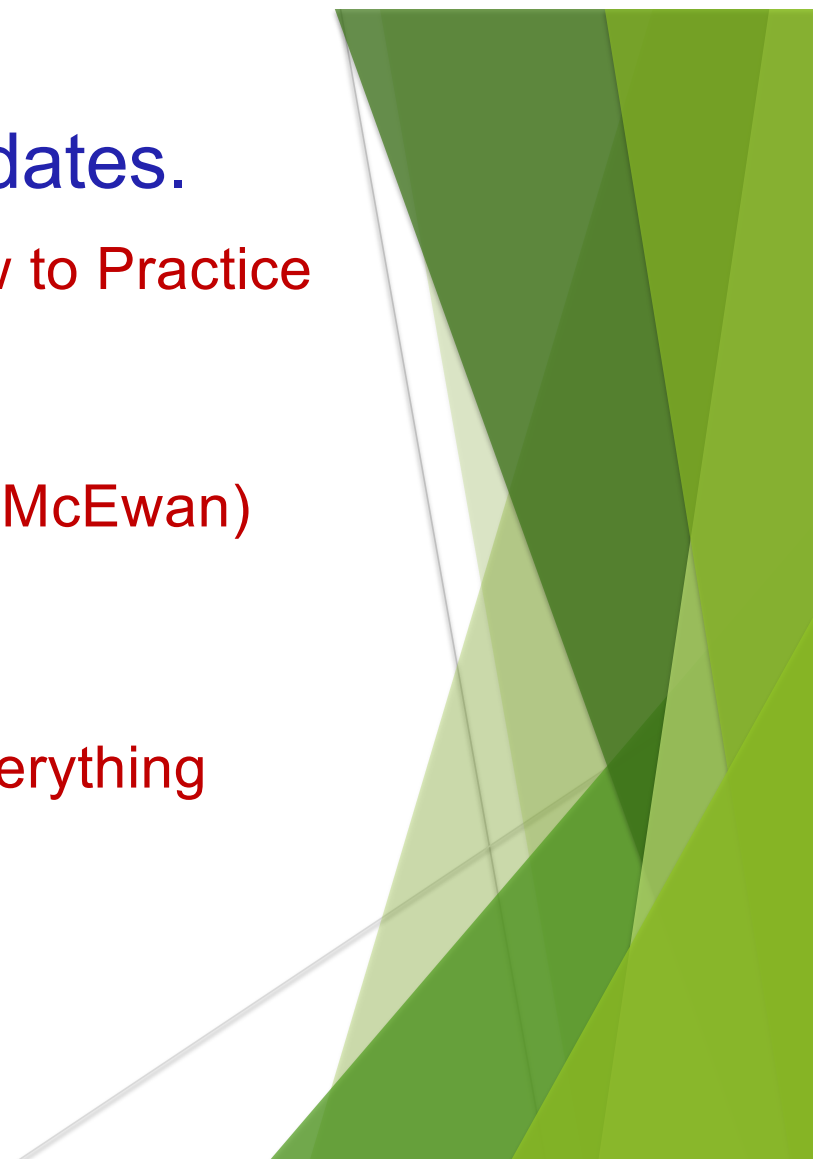
The tech will be donated to non profits across Tucson that can adequately recycle or refurbish the old tech.
